Habitat for Humanity of New York State brings people together to build homes, communities and hope. Throughout our 2018-2019 fiscal year, we worked to incorporate that mission into all we did, as we continue to support affiliates across the state. We support affiliates through training & technical assistance, advocacy, and resource development.

In 2018-19, Habitat NYS hosted our annual state conference for Habitat affiliates in Binghamton, NY. This 3-day conference included workshops for ReStore employees, executive directors, volunteer managers, homeowner services staff, and volunteers. Staff, board members, and volunteers from across the state attended this event. We also held our Summer Symposium in June, which focused on homeowner services and included sessions on New York State mortgage procedures and marketing to the new Habitat home buyer.

We held an advocacy training in Albany in late January in conjunction with our annual advocacy day where affiliates met with their representatives about policy priorities surrounding affordable home ownership.

We continued our participation in the Affordable Housing Corporation (AHC)


grant, a state grant through the New York State Department of Homes and Community Renewal that provides funding for affiliates to build new homes and rehabilitate existing homes. We secured a Rural Community Development Initiative grant through the United States Department of Agriculture. This grant allows us to provide capacity building technical assistance and scholarship funding to 11 participating rural affiliates.

Our affiliate advisory council members continue to serve the community, providing valuable information regarding grant administration, training, communication, strategic planning, and advocacy.

What is most important is the work our affiliates have done to promote affordable homeownership across New York State. Habitat for Humanity volunteers and staff members have built and rehabilitated homes, provided critical home repairs, and forged partnerships with other organizations to help us build a New York where everyone has a decent place to live. We are inspired, motivated, and enthusiastic about growing and serving Habitat affiliates across New York State going forward.




Habitat's Partnership with New York State

The New York State Department of Homes and Community Renewal has been supportive of Habitat's efforts in the state for years. We are grateful for the work that the Affordable Housing Corporation (AHC) and the State of New York Mortgage Agency (SONYMA) have done to help us move towards a NY where everyone has a decent place to live. Since 2000, Habitat affiliates across the state have built or rehabilitated 648 homes thanks to grant funding from AHC. SONYMA has been a partner to Habitat affiliates, providing a Habitat-specific, low-interest mortgage product to Habitat homebuyers. This has helped to ensure we are collectively able to provide affordable homeownership opportunities. Our continued partnership with the state is vital to achieving our mission.
